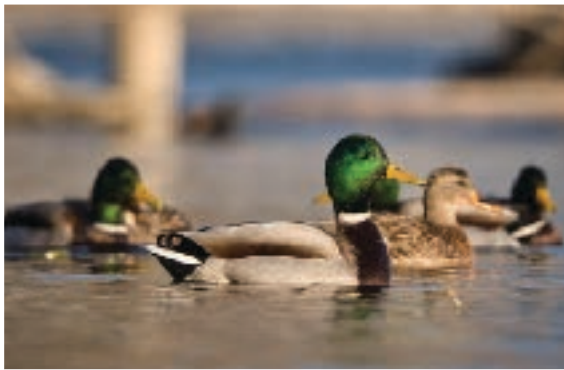




MMF Wetland Monitoring Program
